BEI and DED win Gold Award from IEDC

Two Alaska economic development organizations recognized for excellence

ANCHORAGE, AK—Last evening the International Economic Development Council (IEDC) presented the University of Alaska Anchorage Business Enterprise Institute (BEI), in partnership with the State of Alaska Division of Economic Development, a Gold Award of Excellence in the Business Retention and Expansion Special Event category.

The award recognized both agencies for organizing a tour promoting unmanned aircraft systems opportunities in Alaska. Each year, IEDC presents these awards to the world's most influential leaders in economic development programs and partnerships, and this was the first award in this category for BEI. Four other Alaskan organizations won awards: Alaska Industrial Development & Export Authority, Anchorage Economic Development Corporation, Haa Aani Community Development Fund, and Huna Totem Corporation.
